volimo li više šetnju centrom mjesta Selca, koja je, zahvaljujući tako očitoj klesarskoj vještini, doživljaj sama po sebi, pogled na monumentalnu Bračku katedralu - neoromaničku crkvu Krista Kralja sa svojih 45 m visine, ili pak šetnju Parkom Tolstoj i Parkom zahvalnosti, koji objedinjuju biste kako čuvenog Lava Nikolajeviča Tolstoja, tako i Franje Tuđmana, Aloisa Mocka i Hansa Dietricha Genschera - istaknutih političara zaslužnih za priznanje Hrvatske u svijetu... ali, ovog puta vodimo Vas i u Povelja. Ondje će kulturolojupce ostaviti bez daha starokršćanska bazilika s krstionicom i rimskim spomenicima, a činjenica da su u Poveljima nađeni i povaljski prag te povaljska listina – najstariji pisani dokumenti na hrvatskom ćirilicom pismu, čini ovo mjesto pravom kolijevkom kulture. Znamenitostima tu nije kraj - zamolite gostoljubive mještane da Vam pokažu stijene na kojima je, vjeruje se, sjedio i molio se Sveti Ivan! Osim Reda Svetog Ivana na kojem je svetac navodno ostavio svoje otiske, imat ćete prilike uživati i u pogledu na Dramotinj, prekrasnu uvalu do Povalja.

WE CAN'T REALLY DECIDE

if we prefer a walk through the very centre of Selca, which, thanks to such incredible stone-masonry it boasts, is an experience in itself, a view of the monumental Brač Cathedral - the neo-Romanesque church of Christ the King with its impressive 45 metres of height, or a walk through Tolstoj Park and the Park of Gratitude, which brings together the busts of the famous Leo Tolstoy, as well as that of former Croatian President Dr. Franjo Tuđman, as well as Alois Mock and Hans Dietrich Genscher - prominent politicians responsible for the recognition of the Republic of Croatia as an independent country across the rest of the world... This time we are also going to be taking you to beautiful Povelja. The ancient Christian basilica with the baptistery and Roman monuments located there will leave culture lovers absolutely speechless, and the fact that the Charter of Povelja was found here (as you'll notice from its name) - the oldest written document in the Croatian Cyrillic script - makes this pretty place a true cradle of culture. The sights don't end there, though! Make sure to ask some of the hospitable locals to show you the rocks on which, it is believed, Saint John himself sat and prayed! In addition to the Order of St. John, where the saint supposedly left his footprints, you will also have the opportunity to enjoy the view of Dramotinj, a beautiful bay near Povelja.

We'll be honest, we fell in love with Selca a very long time ago - we can't resist the vibrant energy of the local culture that this place exudes at quite literally every single turn, and we have no doubt that it will all enchant you too! The irresistible asset of this municipality on the eastern side of the island, which is commonly referred to as the gate of Brač, offers the possibility of combining active holidays with pleasure in the gorgeous Mediterranean ambience and with great cultural assets on offer, and we know where to go and what's worth seeing!



DRAMOTINJ BEACH, WHICH IS ONLY A TEN-MINUTE WALK

from the very heart of the town, is surrounded by a thick Mediterranean pine forest and is just one of the well known addresses for enjoying the blue of the Adriatic Sea and the equally deep blue sky above - there are also attractive bays such as Tičja luka and Točinjka, and pebble-concrete beaches like Ratac and Okuč. If your focus is going to be primarily on the local beaches, then we also highly recommend the beautiful Sumartin, which captivates its visitors easily with its picturesque bays with natural pebbles, such as Sv. Rok, Planik, Puntica, Lučica and Rasotica, and the beautiful pebble beach Puntinac, which lies just west of Selca and Sumartin.

UPRAVO JE GUSTOM BOROVIŠTOM OKRUŽENA

Rok, Planik, Puntica, Lučica i Rasotica, te prekrasna šljunčana plaža Puntinac zapadno od Selca i Sumartina.

Uživajte u razgledu pustinje Blaca, Zmajeve špilje, klesarske škole... a na svakoj lokaciji, na zadnjoj stranici karte koju možete preuzeti u nekom od Turističko – informativnih centara na otoku, možete otisnuti i pečat.

VIA BRATTIA - THE COMMON DENOMINATOR BRINGING TOGETHER NUMEROUS ATTRACTIONS ON THE ISLAND

When it comes to more attractions to be tried out on beautiful Brač - in fact, the most important ones are all in one place! - discover the 140-kilometre-long circular tourist-mountaineering path called Via Brattia, which brings together as many as twelve of the most attractive cultural and historical island locations into one magnificent experience.. Enjoy a tour of the Blaca Hermitage, the Dragon's Cave, the local stonemasonry school... and at each location, on the last page of the map, which you can download from one of the Tourist Information Centres on the island, you can print a stamp. Once you have collected all twelve stamps, the coat of arms of the island of Brač will be created in front of you - a picture of the island's patron saint, Saint (Croatian: Sveti) Juraj, which will serve as a great memory of your time spent on this stunning island.
